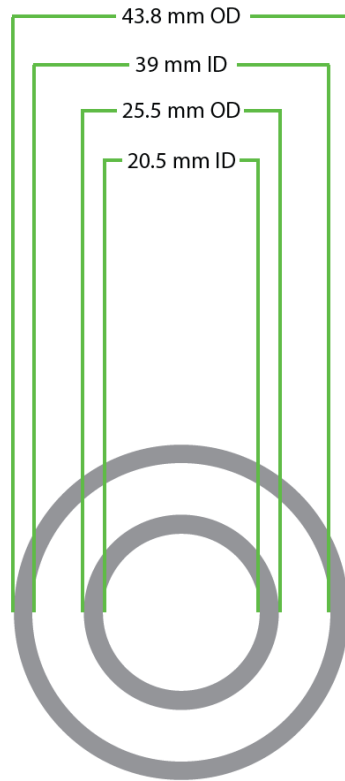

Quick Reference Labelart Specifications and Design Tips

Traditionally, DVD 10 labelart printing has been double-sided print.

Technicolor prefers the use of the single-sided print option, rather than the traditional double-sided option.

| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Electronic files only for DVD 10 labelart. The shaded area of the image above represents the printable area. Do not deviate from the printable area. Modifying the printable area can affect the clamping area in the center-hub and may lead to playability issues. Minimum font point size: 5.5 pt. San Serif Font (Preferred: Futura Medium Condensed and Futura Bold Condensed) Use all capital letters. Avoid squeezing too many characters in your design. Abbreviating such text as: FULL FRAME to FF, WIDESCREEN to WS, eliminating ALL RIGHTS RESERVED on the center ring are encouraged and will help maintain text legibility. Do not horizontal scale text below 70%. Minimum line width: 0.5 pt. Minimum line width knockout/reversed: 0.75 pt. Number of allowable colors: Minimum 2, Maximum 3. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Collect for output, all graphic elements (links) and fonts (printer and screen). Include sub-ordinate fonts used in linked graphic elements. Vantiva will trap your electronic file. Indicate all colors required. This includes white floods or custom white. Vantiva recommends the use of white under all PMS colors. Without a white base under the PMS color, the desired color(s) may vary due to the metallic reflection. Specify all knockout elements and their final appearance. This will ensure Vantiva meets your desired finished product. Color-accurate proofs are not required for DVD 10 labelart submissions. Vantiva will match the Pantone Solid Coated colors called out with a 1/2 shade. Do not create a bleed when designing DVD 10 labelart. |
