SOURCE MEDIA REQUIREMENTS	
1.	All Ultra HD Blu-ray images must be authored to accept AAC2 encryption. Vantiva can accept both pre-encrypted (Type-C) and unencrypted (Type-A) AAC2 images. Unencrypted AAC2 images will be submitted to AAC2 for certification.
2.	Digital upload via Aspera is our preferred method of delivery. This method requires a pre-arranged Aspera connectivity. If using Aspera, Vantiva supports only Aspera products that interface with our Aspera Enterprise Server; we do not support Aspera Faspex or the Aspera Connect Browser Plug-in. The upload must be identified using the Vantiva Global Identification Label (GIL) naming convention. Contact your assigned Vantiva Customer Service Representative for GIL naming requirements.
3.	If physical media is provided, Vantiva accepts LTO tapes or a USB 2.0/3.0 external storage device (2.5 or 3.5 inch form factor HDD or SSD). LTO tapes must be written using Windows Backup. Physical media should be clearly labeled with the customer catalog number, and should contain a UHDCMF file set at the root directory level. Contact your assigned Vantiva Customer Service Representative with any questions.
